DVRT Advocates, who serve on an on-call basis, and respond to police headquarters at the victim's time of crisis to *confidentially* provide the victim with:

Support and Advocacy
Legal Rights (Restraining Orders)
Safety Planning
Referrals for Services (Counseling, Safe House, etc.)
Dynamics of DV

- all of which can help to empower a victim to make whatever decisions she/he chooses to about their own life and the lives of their children. *Bi-lingual capability is a plus.*
