Dear Parents and Guardians:

Earlier today, Governor Murphy officially announced that all public schools in New Jersey will be closed for the remainder of the school year for “live” instruction. While we did anticipate that there would be an announcement to close schools, we did not receive any more information about what SBS will need to do to reopen in September or about any other operational guidelines that will be necessary once we return. The Governor also canceled the remainder of the spring sports season for high school students and said that more information would be available soon regarding graduations, commencements, proms, and other end-of-year activities.

Once I have more information about returning to school and our important activities normally scheduled for May and June, I will let everyone know. The Shrewsbury Borough School will continue delivering instruction to all of our students utilizing our virtual, home instruction model as we have been since March 12. I encourage you to communicate with our faculty and staff if you have any concerns about your child’s progress and I thank you for your continued partnership which is necessary for the success of our students.
