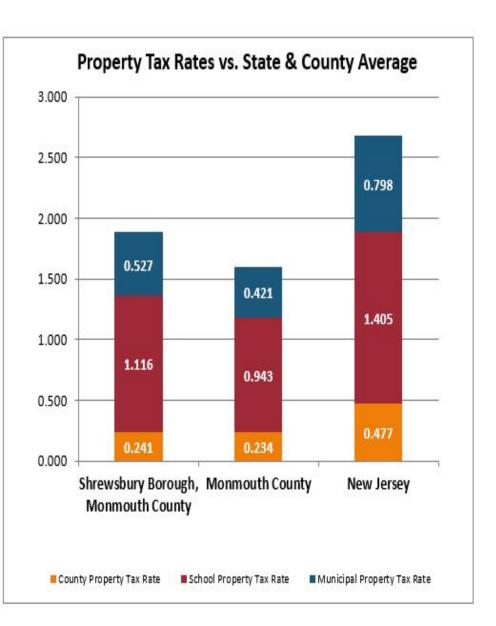

### Fund Breakdown

#### **General Fund = \$10,350,139**

- **Local Tax Levy** (\$9,413,833) money collected by taxes from the community
- **Miscellaneous Revenue** (\$936,306)
  - □ State Aid (\$599,512 of the \$936,306)
    - □ Special Education Categorical Aid supplements Federal allocations under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act
    - Security Aid
    - ☐ Transportation Aid
    - ☐ Extraordinary Aid
  - **Tuition** (\$78,510 of \$936,306)
  - □ Interest
  - **■** Excess Surplus
  - **□** Reserve Withdrawal

### Fund Breakdown

### Special Revenue Fund = \$182,979

- **Federal Grants** IDEA Individuals with Disabilities Education Act

#### **Debt Service Fund = \$1,680,000**

- ☐ Principal and interest payments on bonds approved in previous referendum for additions and renovations on school buildings
- □ Shrewsbury Tax Levy \$1,377,959
- □ State Aid Debt Service \$ 302,041 (2<sup>nd</sup> year as a tax savings)

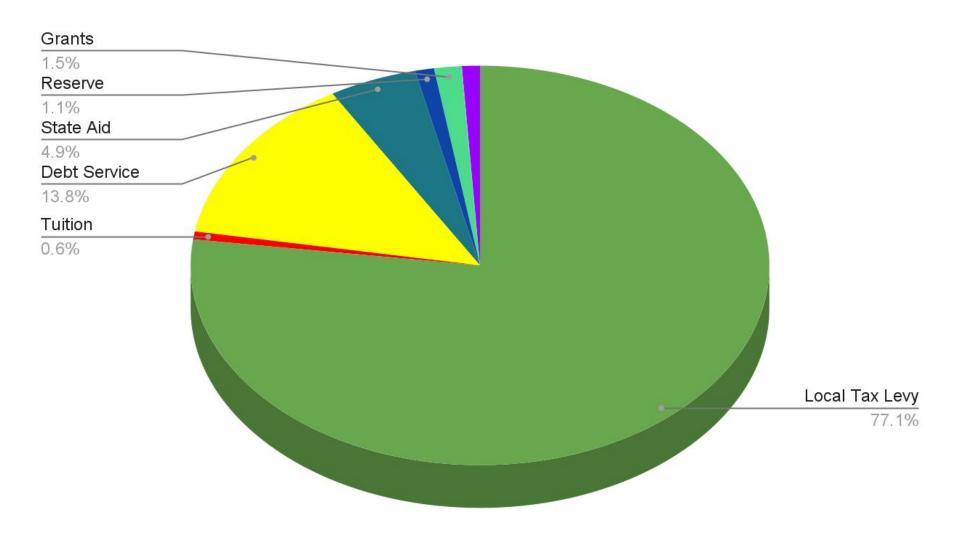

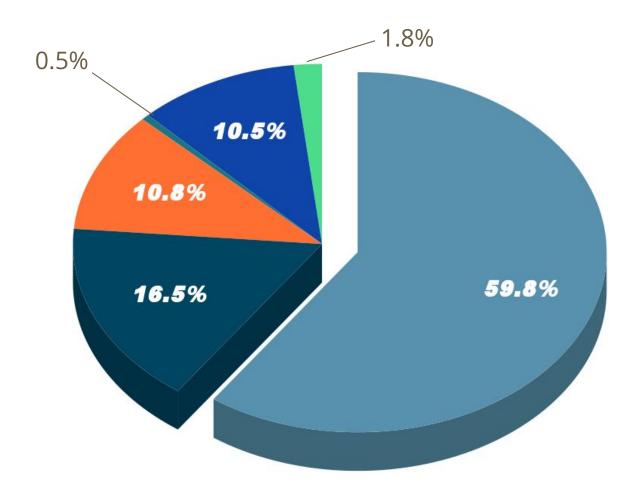

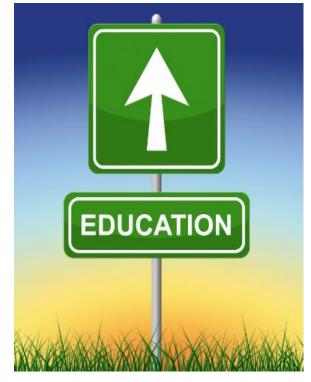
